## Vital signs taking

measure the basic functions of your body. They include your body temperature, blood pressure, pulse and respiratory (breathing) rate

## Accurate Injection Sites

Sites of the thigh (Rectus femoris and Vastus lateralis) · The dorsogluteal site · The deltoid site · The ventrogluteal site · Administering an IM injection

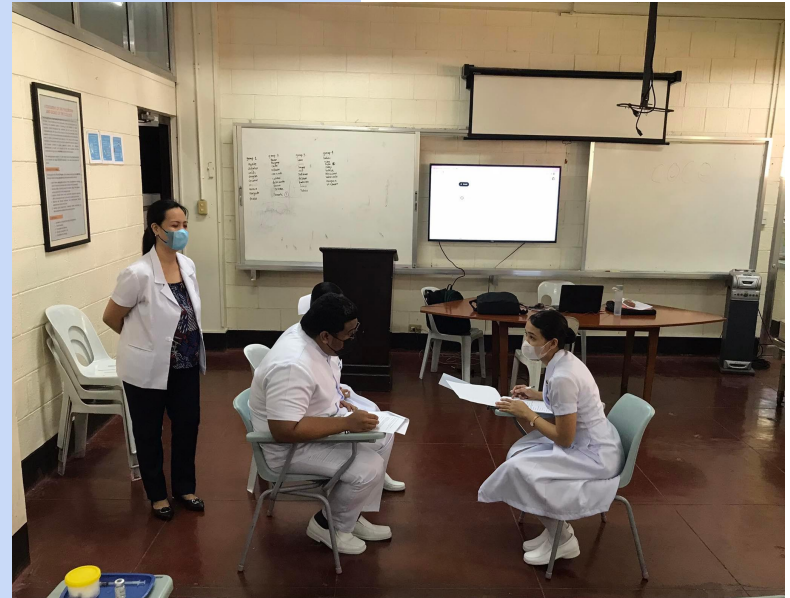


